### **Registration obligations**

Registration as a teacher carries with it a number of obligations including the requirement to:

- maintain your teacher registration which includes the requirement to pay an annual fee by 31 March each year
- provide written notice to the TRBWA within 30 days of a change of name, postal address, email address or telephone number
- provide written consent to the TRBWA, upon request, to obtain a criminal history check
- comply with any conditions placed on your registration
- continue to be a fit and proper person to be registered
- provide written notice to the TRBWA, under sections 38, 39 and 40 of the *Teacher Registration Act 2012* (Act) about:
  - civil proceedings which result in orders to pay damages or compensation (within 30 days)

- convicted or found guilty of an offence which includes a statutory penalty of imprisonment (within 30 days)
- loss of qualifications that enabled teacher registration (within 30 days)
- Working with Children notices and assessments (within 14 days).

Registered teachers are required to pay an annual fee for their teacher registration every year. An annual fee invoice for the next year of registration will be forwarded to you in February.

### **Maintaining registration**

To renew your Full Registration, you must meet a number of requirements, including mandatory professional engagement requirements in an educational institution in Australia or New Zealand. In addition, there are requirements for professional learning and continuing to be a fit and proper person to be registered, which are available on the TRBWA website [trb.wa.gov.au](http://trb.wa.gov.au).

- update your contact details and your current school/educational institution
- view and update your professional learning records
- access and download copies of correspondence.
